To think about

Illness, accident or death often means that your life will change and you will be faced with issues that might feel difficult and unfamiliar.

It can be good to talk to an outsider about your thoughts and feelings.

The welfare officer can help you move on with your life.

The welfare officer treats everything in the strictest confidence.

You can see a welfare officer without a referral.

You need to pay for the visits; you can use your 'high cost card'.
